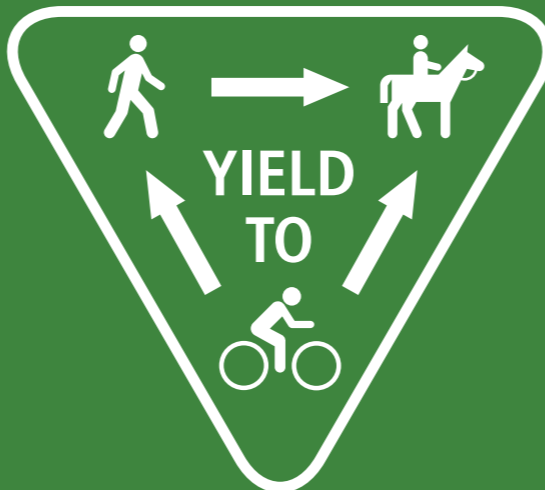
Trail Etiquette

- Respect all other trail users.
- Travel at a safe speed and stay in control.
- Throw all trash into trash cans.
- Recycle if available.
- Motorized vehicles are prohibited.
- Respect the environment.

- Keep dogs on a six foot handheld leash and under control at all times.
- Immediately pick up and properly dispose of dog waste.
- Violations are subject to Municipal Code Sections 4-10 and 4-12.

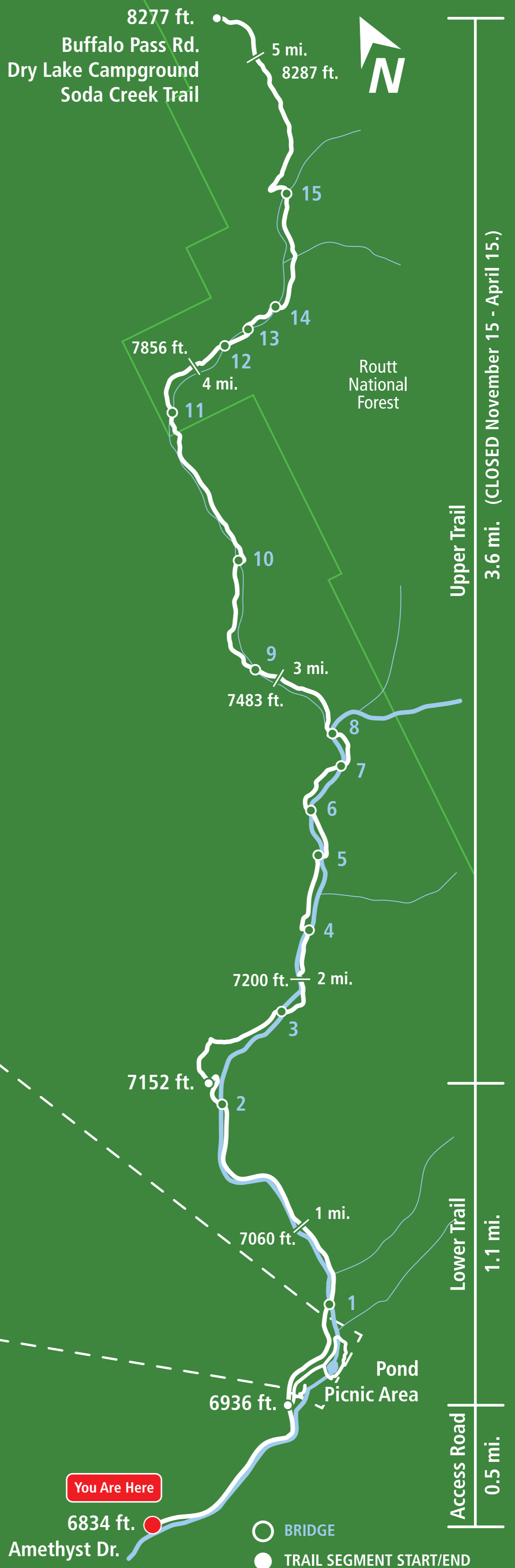
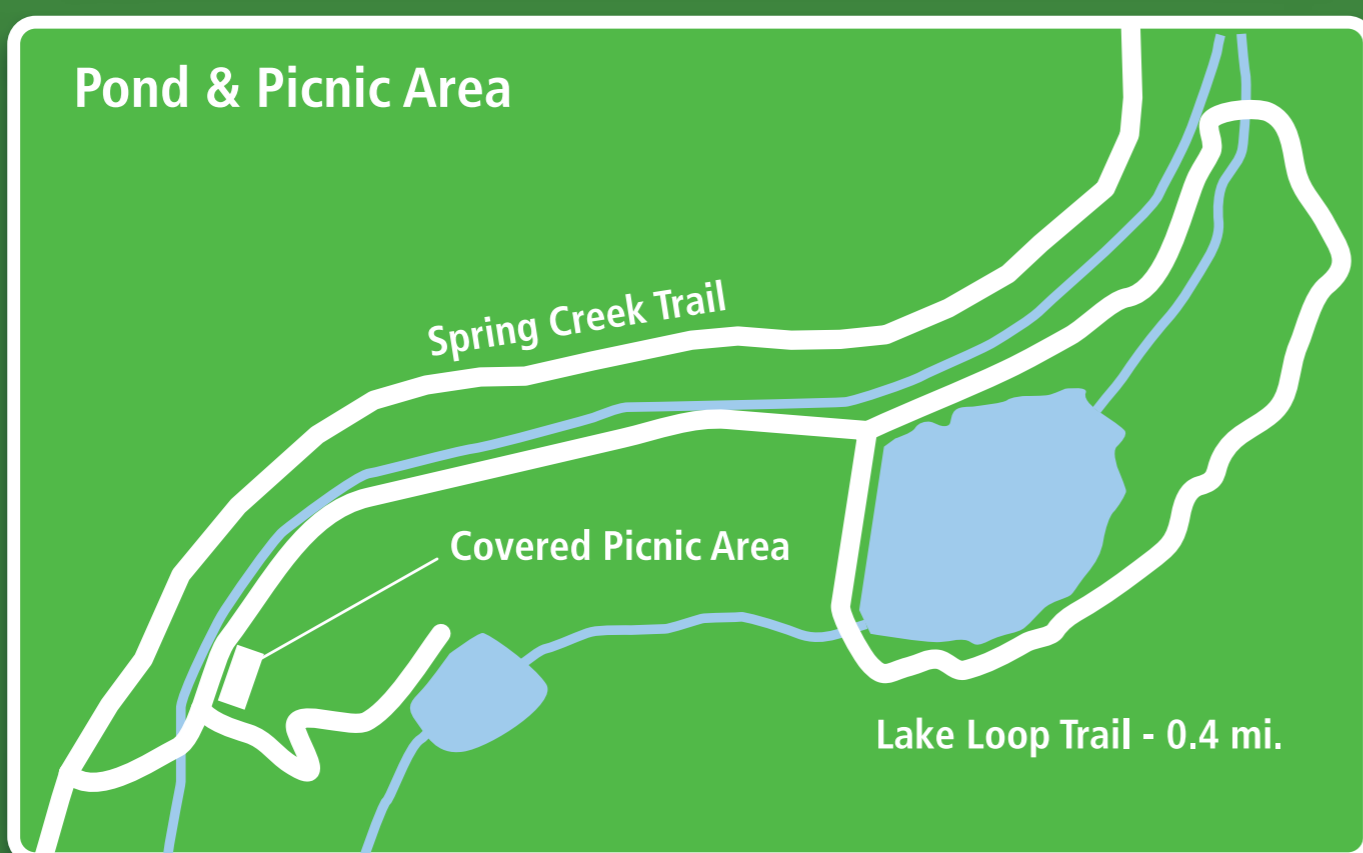
