KEEP FIRE HYDRANTS ACCESSIBLE

Did you know that a fire can move two feet per second...and that a fire can double in size every minute? Every second counts in the event of a fire! It is critical that fire fighters are quickly able to access fire hydrants to protect your home and business. There are over 800 fire hydrants in Steamboat Springs. The City and Mount Werner Water strive to keep these hydrants accessible, but we need your help to keep them clear of snow and other obstructions.

- Don't shovel or blow any snow in the plowed area around a fire hydrant
- No object should be within 15 feet of a hydrant (such as a fence, sign, landscaping, rocks, etc.)
- If you obstruct access to a fire hydrant, you may be issued a citation.

WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Parking problems are compounded by winter snow, which accumulates fast with each storm. In order to expedite snow removal efforts, parking is prohibited on City streets and shoulders during the following hours from November 1 through April 30.

Location	Restricted Hours
Lincoln Avenue:	3 a.m. to 6 a.m.
Ski Time Square:	3 a.m. to 6 a.m.
Anglers Drive area and south to city limits:	Midnight to 8 a.m.
All Other Areas:	2 a.m. to 8 a.m.

Your vehicle may be ticketed if left on City streets within the restricted hours or towed during snowplow operations within the restricted hours.
