HELP US ACCESS YOUR WATER METER TOUCHPAD

Our meter reader must be able to quickly and easily access your meter reading touchpad in order to collect accurate readings for your water bill. The touchpad is a 3" by 2" black oval with a half dollar sized "button". It is located on the outside of your house. During winter months it is important to shovel a path to the touchpad and keep the touchpad area clear of ice and snow. The City reserves the right to estimate your water consumption if we are unable to access the touchpad. If you have any questions on the location of your touchpad, please call Barb at 819-9127.
