



HIGH WATER PREPAREDNESS

Due to the above average snow water equivalent for the Yampa River Basin, high water is expected for our area. The extent of the high water is dependent on many factors, including temperature and precipitation. If you live in a floodplain or near the Yampa River or any of its tributaries; please pay close attention to the rising water. Please take a look around your property to make sure all drainage areas are free of obstructions and remove any debris that may create an obstruction during high water. If you are in a high water prone area it is suggested that you take extra precautions and move valuables to higher elevations. Keep in mind that most valuables outside of a home and within a basement (except for certain appliances and mechanical equipment) are not covered under your flood insurance policy. Please contact your insurance provider if you have specific questions regarding your policy.

Please stay tuned to local radio in the event of significant high water.

SPRING/SUMMER CONSTRUCTION:

Construction in Steamboat is in full swing this spring. Along with the positives of development and redevelopment come the temporary headaches and inconveniences we can all identify with. In an effort to minimize problems, it is our goal to keep the community informed of upcoming work. The following projects involve infrastructure upgrades and street improvements. Please note the project locations and plan accordingly. Well marked detours will be in place to safely guide you around the work.

>To assist Mt. Werner Water, the City wishes to notify you of the closure of **Whistler Road** from Walton Creek Road to Stone Lane between the dates of April 28-July 18. The purpose of the closure is to replace the existing water and sewer mains which are located within Whistler Road. Additionally, delays may be experienced along Walton Creek Road as improvements are being made. Traffic will be required to follow the project detour to access Whistler Road.

> The second year of the Steamboat Springs Redevelopment Authority's construction of improvements in the Base Area includes the reconstruction of the **Après Ski Way-Mt. Werner Circle** intersection. The intersection will be transformed into a roundabout to provide improved traffic flow. Construction is planned from April 21 to September 15, 2008.

While all of this construction is happening, dedicated efforts are being made by the project team to ensure continuous and safe access, for both vehicles and pedestrians, within the project area. During April and May, traffic will be flagged through the construction zone with only minimal delays.

IT'S YARD SALE SEASON

You CAN'T; post your signs on power, telephone and traffic poles, or park a vehicle advertising your yard sale.

You CAN; post signs without a permit directing the public to yard or garage sales that are no larger than four square feet. Signs cannot be put up for more than three days prior to the sale and must be removed no later than two days after the event. ALL SIGNS MUST HAVE THE DATES OF SALE POSTED! Remember to keep the signs out of city right-of-way and get permission if posted on private property. You will have to remove your signs within two days after your sale.
