## IMPORTANT ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

**Après Ski Way between Mt Werner Circle and Village Drive will be closed for construction from June 9 through June 27.** This will be a 24 hour continuous closure until the work is completed on the roundabout at the intersection of Mt. Werner Circle and Après Ski Way.

Traffic needing to access Après Ski Way east of Village Drive will need to use Village Drive from Walton Creek Road. Vehicles making their way up Mt. Werner Circle will be redirected to Eagle Ridge Drive by project flaggers during this detour.

## ATTENTION DOG OWNERS A DOG LICENSE IS MANDATORY IN THE CITY AND COUNTY

A yearly license is required for all dogs within the city limits of Steamboat Springs and within Routt County limits. You may acquire a license at the Animal Shelter located at 760 Critter Court, Monday – Friday 12:00-5:30 p.m., Saturday, 12-4:00 p.m. and Sunday, 12-2:00 p.m. Bring your rabies certificate. The license is \$5.00 for altered dogs and \$25.00 for unaltered dogs.

Please remember to keep your dog on a leash six feet or less and under control.
