THE STEAMBOAT SPRINGS CITY COUNCIL WANTS THE PUBLIC TO BE AWARE OF AN IMPORTANT UPCOMING MEETING:

On February 10, 2009 City Council will hold its second worksession on affordable housing policies and philosophy, and the Yampa Valley Housing Authority.

City Council will be considering major amendments to the City's Community Housing Program including significantly amending the existing Community Housing Ordinance, allowing payment in lieu for all community housing units, and repealing portions or all of the Community Housing Ordinance. City Council will also revisit the use of payment in lieu funds and discuss the City's role with the Yampa Valley Housing Authority. This is a worksession only so no final policy determinations will be made. This public meeting will begin at 5:00pm in Citizens' Meeting Room and public comment will be accommodated.

Interested citizens are encouraged to attend this important meeting.
