

Drop-In Hockey Policy

Sign in and fee collection will begin 1 hour prior to the scheduled ice time. Participants can sign in others with payment. **Phone reservations will be taken, if you have a punch card on file. NO refunds will be issued, once reservation has been made and card has been punched.**

You must talk to a staff person; NO phone messages will be accepted.

Signature is still required to play. No phone calls inquiring about how many people have signed up will be tolerated.

Cost is **\$10.00** for adults (18 and older) and **\$9.00** for youth (17 & younger). Adult “10 punch cards” cost **\$90**, and youth cards are **\$80**. Players must sign in and pay upon entering. Failure to do so may result in losing your space on the ice.

A maximum of **24** skaters and **4** goalies allowed for each session. NO EXCEPTIONS. This is first-come, first-served basis.

After drop-in is over, please exit the ice promptly, move nets to either the bleacher side of the arena or zamboni end.

There is to be “NO” puck play after Zam gates are opened. Anyone continuing play will be given a warning and then asked not to return. This is for the safety of employees and participants.

DROP-IN LEVEL DEFINITIONS:

ADULT ALL: Is open to A, B, and C level players and goalies.

ADULT REC: Is open to REC/C level players. “15 Minute Rule”: If not full 15 minutes prior to start of session, then ONLY **B** players are allowed to play. **B** players must play down to the level of play or they will be asked to leave. **Goalies** – Only REC/C goalies are allowed to sign up, **if there are not 2 REC/C goalies** signed up 15 minutes before drop-in begins then an upper level goalie will be allowed to sign in.

ADULT A/B: Is open to A and B level players. **Goalies** - Only A/B goalies are allowed to sign up, **if there are not 2 A/B goalies** signed up 15 minutes before drop-in begins a lower level goalie will be allowed to sign in.

ADULT DROP-IN: 18 YEARS AND OLDER.

YOUTH DROP-IN: Is open to anyone under 17 years old. The Ice Arena will attempt to provide supervision for all youth drop-ins.

FAMILY DROP-IN: Is designed for youth players to skate with a parent or guardian.

SENIOR DROP-IN: Is open to anyone 35 and over.
