### ROADSIDE TRASH ON THE INCREASE

Please remember that a vehicle shall not be driven or moved on a highway if the vehicle is transporting trash or recyclables unless the load is covered by a tarp or other cover in a manner that prevents the load from blowing, dropping, shifting, leaking, or otherwise escaping from the vehicle.

### WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Parking problems are compounded by winter snow, which accumulates fast with each storm. In order to expedite snow removal efforts, parking is prohibited on City streets and shoulders during the following hours from NOVEMBER 1 through APRIL 30.
