Avoid Conflicts By:

Attention all Property Owners:

Colorado State Law requires that all land owners manage noxious weeds on their properties. Whitetop is one of the first noxious weeds to appear and can be found throughout the area. The plant has white flowers, is capable of vigorous growth and produces many seeds that remain viable for many years. The Steamboat Springs Community Development Code enables fines of up to \$999.00 per day/per violation for private property owners not in compliance with the Routt County Weed Plan.
