Concrete Skate Park Update

The City of Steamboat Springs has applied for a grant through Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO) to help with the funding needed to build a concrete skate park. GOCO will be reviewing and awarding funding to successful grant recipients the third week of June.

John Casson with Skate Park Alliance is continuing fundraising activities including in-kind donations of materials, labor and equipment.

Next steps will be further site and skate park design efforts. These include grading and drainage, site layout along with taking the skate park design from the conceptual level to the construction level.

Sewage Lagoon decommissioning is moving forward although the skate park location has moved from the East cell to the West. This cell will be available for construction in August if the project is funded.

Further updates will be based on the design and fundraising efforts.
