IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

- October 5, 2009:** Last day to register to vote in Colorado.
- October 13-16, 2009:** Mail Ballots to voters, C.R.S. 1-7.5-107(3)(a).
- October 27, 2009:** Last day to request a Mail Ballot to be mailed.
- October 30, 2009:** Last day to apply for a "Carried" Mail Ballot. Request for Ballot must be in person at the County Clerk's Office.

November 3, 2009 ELECTION DAY.

ALL BALLOTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY 7 P.M.

- If your mailing address is your residential address, this is where the ballot will be mailed.
- If you will be at an address other than your mailing or residential address during this election, you may request, in writing, a mail ballot sent to another address.

ENTERPRISE ZONE PROGRAM EXPIRES JANUARY 1, 2010

At its meeting on August 18, 2009, City Council determined that the Enterprise Zone program succeeded in its intent to encourage new businesses and expansion of businesses in the designated industrial enterprise zone, and City Council unanimously voted to allow the program to expire on January 1, 2010, as originally intended.

As of January 1, 2010, the Enterprise Zone exemption from City Sales and Use Tax is discontinued. The discontinuance of this exemption includes but is not limited to: supplies, building materials, parts, equipment, machinery, machine tools, trucks, automobiles, construction machinery, construction equipment and utilities including electric, gas, and telephone services.
