October 27, 2009: Last day to request a Mail Ballot to be mailed.

October 30, 2009: Last day to apply for a "Carried" Mail Ballot.
Request for Ballot must be in person at the County Clerk's Office.

November 3, 2009 ELECTION DAY.

ALL BALLOTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY 7 P.M.

• If your mailing address is your residential address, this is where the ballot will be mailed.

• If you will be at an address other than your mailing or residential address during this election, you may request, in writing, a mail ballot sent to another address.

Important - Everyone should sign up. Routt County has contracted with Emergency Communications Network to license its CodeRED high-speed notification system. The CodeRED system provides county officials the ability to quickly deliver messages to targeted areas or the entire county. You may access the secure site by going to the City's website at www.steamboatsprings.net and clicking on the CodeRED link.
