Continuation of the Spring Creek Trail Closure

The City of Steamboat Springs closed the Spring Creek Trail at Amethyst Drive for hazard tree removal and fire break operations on Friday, January 8. As additional work continues within this area, this trail will remain closed until further notice.

Rogue Resources will be cutting and removing beetle killed trees under a contract with the City of Steamboat Springs. The Spring Creek Trail is closed to all public access with barricades and signage in place while this work is in progress. The City is requesting that all trail users respect these closures as heavy equipment and tree removal operations will be ongoing during this time frame.

This work is funded by a High Priority Forest Fuels Mitigation grant that was awarded by the Colorado State Forest Service and is directed at restoring forest health by removing dead and diseased trees.
