THE STEAMBOAT 700 REFERENDUM ELECTION will be held March 9, 2010 and will be an ALL MAIL BALLOT.

Please be aware that the last day to register to vote in this election is February 8, 2010. You may register to vote up to this date at the Routt County Clerk and Recorders Office.

If you are not going to be at your regular mailing address during this time, you may request that your ballot be mailed to a different address (mail ballots will not be forwarded). An "application for absentee" form is available on the City's website at www.steamboatsprings.net, City Clerk, Voter Information, or you can pick this form up at the front desk of City Hall at 137 10th Street. The application shall be filed no later than the close of business on the Friday immediately preceding the election; except that, if the applicant wishes to receive the mail-in ballot by mail, the application shall be filed no later than the close of business on the seventh day before the election.

If you have moved or changed your mailing address, please complete and return the "Changes in registration within County" form available on the website or at the front desk of City Hall.

The following City of Steamboat Springs Mail Ballot Drop Off Location will be available from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm Monday through Thursday, 7:30 am to 5:30 pm on Friday, March 5, 7:30 am to noon on Saturday, March 6, and 7:30 am to 7:00 pm on Tuesday, March 9, 2010 (election day), located at:
