- **Public comment:**

- **Administrative Business**
 - Minutes January 26th – APPROVED 4-0.
- **Food and Beverage**
 - Contract committee meeting this morning
 - Equipment list has been updated and updated contract should be sent out soon to go over and approve
 - Winter operations:
 - Sleigh ride dinners have been successful, booked up this weekend and next
 - Beginning to prepare for golf season, working on menus and staffing
 - Operations exceeding budget
- **Superintendent**
 - No big updates
 - Business as usual for winter operations, put out summer seasonal job posting
- **Golf Pro- Cody Hasten**
 - Staff Update:
 - Katie and Zach helping with hiring subcommittee for director or instruction
 - 5 Interviews planned for next week for director of instruction position
 - Actively looking to fill open positions
 - Will have a need for staff in the winter at haymaker, especially with the simulator
 - Possibility for additional full-time year-round position
 - a. Would need to go through supplemental budget process to make this happen, typically a 2 month long process
 - b. Opportunity to change the culture and create positive changes
 - c. GMC approves this ask
 - i. Cody will need the support year-round
 - Calendar update:
 - Adam and Cody will dial in start times and make any changes if necessary

- Voyak group wants dates we cannot accommodate, looking to change day
- Pace of play:
 - Discussion of adding in additional starter times to help with pace of play on the course, possibly one every 2 hours, 5 or 6 per day
- Pass sales/punch cards:
 - 160 Season Pass Sales so far
 - 20 more phone calls that need to be made to previous pass holders
 - Important to get the right message out about cap on season passes
 - This is to protect the season pass holder experience, the course and facilities, as well as open up some more tee times
- Orlando Update:
 - Staff retention was a huge topic of discussion across the board
 - Decline in golf staffing, although the sport is busier than ever

 - Marketing subcommittee
 - Meet early March and put together a plan for the year
 - Put together forums
- **Finance- Sue Davies**
 - Open Gov, Managers Dashboard
 - Budgeting information, shows where you are with the budget
