- **Public comment:**
 - Katie relayed an e-mail comment from the public asking Haymaker to open earlier, as the other golf courses in town, according to this person, open earlier.
- **Administrative Business**
 - April 14th Minutes – APPROVED (3-0)
- **Food & Beverage – Kathy Hastings**
 - Good to go for opening on May 13th, with staff beginning as early as May 8th.
 - Front of house training and menu cutting are happening on May 10th and 11th
 - Restaurant, turn window, and park service will all be open for opening day.
 - New draught system will be installed shortly after opening with 6 lines of craft beer being offered.
 - Colorado Golf and Turf will be out today and next week to work on beverage carts and freshen up the canopies.
- **Superintendent Update – Adam Sando**
 - They had the intention of opening the course the first week of May. This has been pushed back a week due to weather.
 - Cleaning up the course, aerification, getting bunkers filled, and putting a first cut on everything are all taking place leading up to opening day.
 - The greens wintered very well, with no snow mold occurring.
 - Tee complexes, the greens, the surrounds, and the partial fairways have been cleaned up and aerification should be finished by EOD today.
 - While vole damage was minimum, the elk damage mitigation has been very time consuming.
 - The rollers purchased has been pushed back to the middle of June due to manufacturing delays.
 - There will be a demo roller for use before this.
 - Practice facility should be open by next week, dependent on weather and staffing allowances.
- **Head Golf Professional – Cody Hasten**
 - In terms of rakes, ball washers, and water the team has been working with the other courses in town to keep things consistent across the valley in terms of Covid precautions and keeping everyone safe & healthy.
 - Haymaker has a lot of new pass holders so far this year.

- Staff has started this past week-helping get the golf shop ready and outside service as needed.
- Distribution issues may pose some problems in regards to rental clubs.
- The rest of the inventory for the golf shop has been received and tagged.
- Push carts are scheduled to ship the end of April.
- The course is working on branding and ball consistency, as the budget permits.
- Tournament registration has been popular and seems to indicate a busy year ahead.
- **Marketing – Katie O’Hara**
 - E-blast should be out this afternoon regarding opening day, April and May updates, and an update from the superintendent.
 - Locals week details will be going out in a separate e-blast to avoid information overload with opening communications.
- **Finance-Sue Davies**
 - The seasonal payrate has been increased due to staffing shortages across all city positions and will affect the budget.
 - Alan and Ian will be meeting next week for the budget sub-committee.
- **Chair Updates – Katie O’Hara**
 - Ordinance updates should be coming out shortly, and can be reviewed between now and the next meeting.
