

May 2020 – June 2021 Scholarship Policy

The City of Steamboat Springs offers partial scholarships up to a maximum of 50% for youth program registrations to those who meet income eligibility guidelines. These funds are limited, and will be awarded to eligible families on a first come-first served basis.

Any child that has been referred to us by school personnel, law enforcement or mental health agencies, a community evaluation team and/or the Routt County Department of Social Services will be considered for a scholarship. Scholarships will also be based on family income.

Parents/guardians must fill out an application and submit it to the Parks & Recreation office. Initial decisions for scholarships will be made on a rolling basis. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.** Any costs not covered by the scholarship including all activity fees are to be paid in full by the parents. Payment plans will be created or adjusted once the scholarship commitments are given. Please check with office staff for details on registration dates or consult the parent manual. Payment options are available; please call 879-4300 for more details.

Below are income guidelines for eligibility. If your gross household income (before taxes) is **less than** the amounts shown under CCCAP guidelines listed below, you might be eligible for tuition assistance through the Routt County Department of Human Services. Please call 879-1540 for more information. If your gross income (before taxes) is less than the amounts shown under City guidelines, or you believe that your family has extenuating circumstances that should be considered, please submit your application and include this information. The closer an applicant's gross income is to the guidelines the higher the scholarship priority. **We have limited funds that will be dispersed based on need.**

IMPORTANT: You must supply a copy of your most recent tax return or a copy of your last two employment check stub(s), verifying employment.
