-Yampa River Core Trail and Walton Creek Trail Bicycle Use Policy-

All Bicycles:

- All bicycles on the Yampa River Core Trail and the Walton Creek Trail must follow Trail Etiquette as posted along the trail.

Electrical Assisted Bicycles (EABs) Pilot Program:

- EABs are defined by Colorado statute as Class 1, 2, or 3. They are not considered motor vehicles under the law, and are permitted on City streets and roads.
- Class 1 EABs will be allowed on the paved portions of the City's Yampa River Core Trail and the Walton Creek Trail as approved in Resolution 2018-18.
- EABs (including Class 1) are not currently permitted on any of the City's other hard or soft surface trails.
- Riders should note that EABs are currently treated as motor vehicles on US Forest Service and BLM properties, and therefore subject to restrictions.

ADA Compliance:

- Under the Americans with Disabilities Act, the City will reasonably accommodate disabled persons using EABs as "other power-driven mobility devices" on City bike trails and paths.
