



Special Edition Town Hall Slated To Discuss Recent Routt County Public Health Order

Virtual Sessions In Partnership with Routt County and Steamboat Pilot & Today

STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO-April 15, 2020-A special Town Hall has been scheduled for tomorrow, Thursday, April 16, to look more in-depth at the most recent Routt County Public Health Order 2020-03, that requires mitigation plans for all businesses.

The session, moderated by Editor Lisa Schlichtman, will take place virtually Thursday from 11am to noon and will feature Routt County Commissioner Tim Corrigan, Routt County Medical Officer Dr. Brian Harrington, Steamboat Springs City Council President Jason Lacy and Steamboat Springs Police Chief Cory Christensen. The panel will cover the order, its intent and what is required by businesses and citizens.

“There have been questions from both businesses and citizens on the recent public health order,” commented Commissioner Corrigan. “We want to address these and share how these measures go directly toward stopping the spread of the coronavirus in our community.”

Numerous town hall sessions have been hosted since March 20, when the first panel discussed the virus. In addition to health, additional sessions have touched upon business, mental health, local government, surge preparedness, kids’ activities as well as a two-part session on non-profits.

Following the special Thursday edition, the regularly scheduled Friday panel on education will take to the digital airwaves. Friday’s session looks at education with the Steamboat Springs School District.
