Prior to joining the department, Stewart worked in the private sector as owner of Rocky Mountain Business Services, LLC which provided an array of services including market research, data organization, synthesizing information, strategic planning, and analysis of workforce service demands. She also spent several years working with a law firm performing duties of a paralegal.

The support services team plays a critical role in performing our mission and I embrace this collaborative endeavor.”
